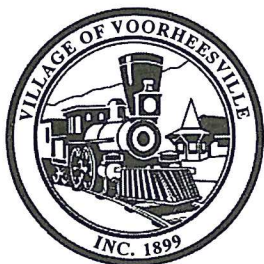

## TIP # A577 (PIN 1760.31): Voorheesville Pedestrian Connectivity

The project plans to improve pedestrian safety and accessibility throughout Voorheesville along some of its most heavily traveled thoroughfares. There have been documented complaints regarding pedestrian safety. The identified sections of sidewalks proposed will ensure children, parents, school staff, and pedestrians in general safe walking access to the Voorheesville Elementary School. The Village of Voorheesville has recognized this project as its highest priority project for funding under the 2016-2021 TIP.

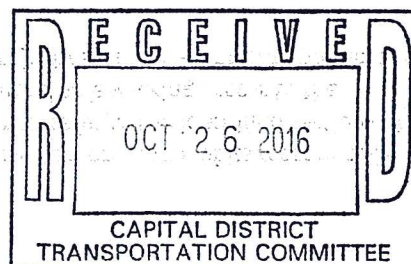
