Amendments to the 2016-21 TIP

At its April 4, 2018 and May 2, 2018 meetings, the CDTC Planning Committee recommended the following amendments to the Transportation Improvement Program (TIP).

1. A588 (1051.82) Albany Skyway, City of Albany

Federal demonstration funds for the I-90 Exit 8 Connector that were never spent have been repurposed and programmed to other projects. This project qualifies because it is in a 50 mile radius of the planned I-90 Exit 8 Connector.

This project (also known as the Albany Corning Preserve Bicycle & Pedestrian Connector Ramp, Phase 1) is the conversion of the Northbound I-787 Ramp from Quay Street to Clinton Avenue to a linear park, connecting Broadway to the Corning Preserve.

2. T108, CDTC108, TDM Multimodal Implementation and T57 (1TR6.04), Preventive Maintenance

The funding for T108 came from RG130 (TDM Set-Aside), which is funded with STP-Flex. TDM strategies are eligible for STP-Flex funding. But when STP-Flex funds are transferred to transit, they must follow eligibility rules for Section 5307. Therefore, some of the TDM strategies in the scope of T108 are not eligible for Section 5307, and therefore are not eligible for transferred STP-Flex funds. Additionally, "Try Transit" was no longer being implemented, and park and ride lot leases had a procedural problem. This action moves the STP-Flex funds that would've been used for those strategies to T57 to fund preventive maintenance for buses. Also, as part of this action, CDTA commits to making up for the funding moved from T108 with local funds.
