



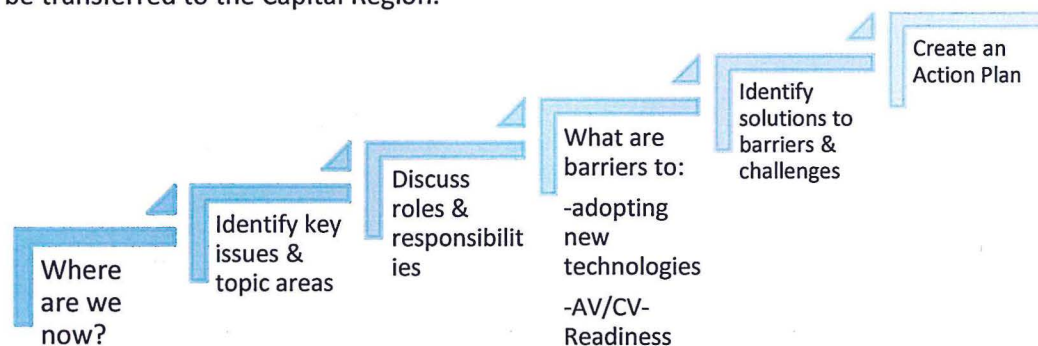

Specific goals of the SMART Communities Task Force include:

- Identify the transportation challenges and needs in the Capital Region and demonstrate how advanced technologies can be used to address issues in safety, mobility, and climate change, now and into the future.
- Determine which technologies, strategies, applications, and institutional arrangements demonstrate the most potential to address and mitigate, if not solve, transportation challenges identified within the region.
- Support and encourage communities to take the evolutionary and revolutionary steps to integrate advanced technologies – including connected and automated vehicle technologies – into management and operations.
- Demonstrate, quantify, and evaluate the impact of these advanced technologies, strategies, and applications towards improved safety, efficiency, and sustainable movement of people and goods.
- Examine the technical, policy, and institutional mechanisms needed for realizing the potential of these strategies and applications – including identifying technical and policy gaps and issues – and work with partners to address them.
- Assess reproducibility and qualify successful smart city systems and services in other cities that can be transferred to the Capital Region.
