The Capital District Transportation Committee (CDTC) is the designated Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) carrying out Federal requirements for cooperative transportation planning and programming within the Albany-Schenectady (-Troy) and Saratoga Springs metropolitan areas. The City of Albany is collaborating with the University at Albany to make further safety improvements after a recent reduction in the posted speed limit and to consider complete street design modifications consistent with the new speed limit. CDTC seeks Expressions of Interest from qualified firms or individuals to identify design concepts and complete streets features that will balance the needs of all roadway users in a manner that enhances quality of life, urban design, the local economy, and safety for all roadway users along this multi-modal and increasingly mixed use corridor.

CDTC, on behalf of the City of Albany, will administer the consultant contract for the project and will assist the City as project manager. The project has a budget of \$90,000 for consultant services. This should be considered the upper limit of the project.
