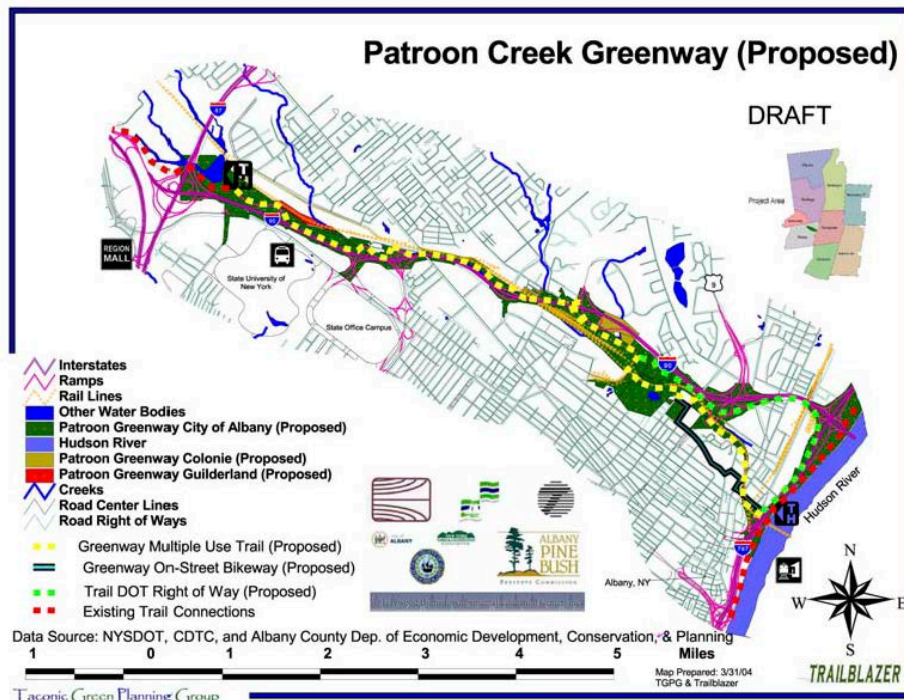


PATROON GREENWAY TRAIL



Total Study Cost: \$24,000 consultant effort

Description: CDTC assisted the W. Haywood Burns Environmental Center with a consultant study to evaluate the feasibility of a bicycle/pedestrian trail between Rensselaer Lake in the Albany Pine Bush and the Corning Preserve in the City of Albany. The proposed trail roughly follows the Patroon Creek and would connect to the Mohawk-Hudson Bike-Hike Trail which begins in Albany. The study will include the development of a trail base map, photographic inventory of trail opportunities or constraints, tax parcel inventory, an investigation of a trail crossing over Central Avenue (NY 5) and an investigation of the type and number of potential trail users.

This study was completed in October 2004.
