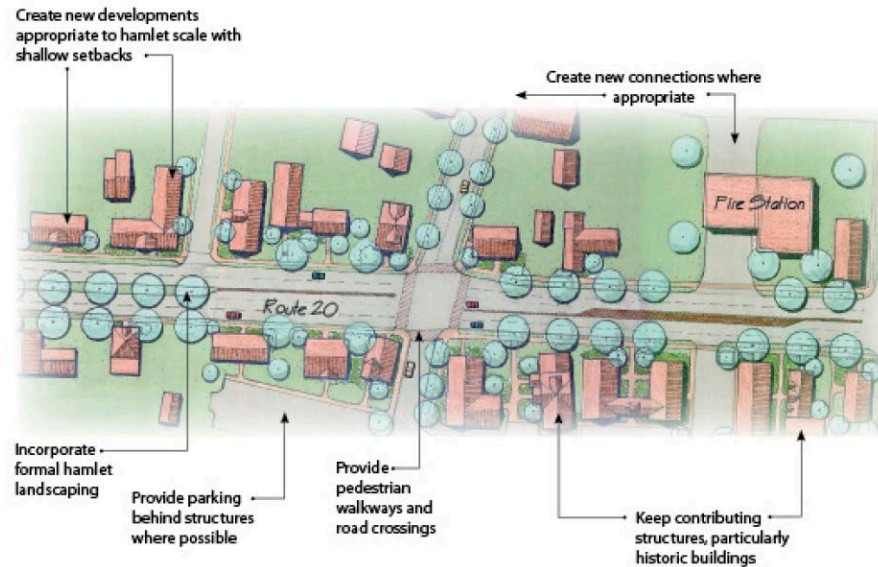


GUILDERLAND HAMLET NEIGHBORHOOD PLAN



Conceptual plan of the Historic Hamlet area of the Route 20 Corridor in the Town of Guilderland, New York.

Total Study Cost: \$52,000 (\$42,000 consultant effort plus \$2,500 in local in-kind services and \$7,500 in CDTC staff technical assistance)

Description: CDTC assisted the Town of Guilderland with a consultant study and staff technical assistance to prepare a master plan for the Guilderland Hamlet. This community planning effort addresses land use, design, and transportation issues for the Guilderland Hamlet Neighborhood. The study area covered a large section of town between Route 155 in the east and Route 146 to the west along US 20 (Western Avenue), which bisects the study area. Through this planning process, consensus was established on the community's long term vision for the area and a strategy for enhancement of the neighborhood was developed. The objective was to create a neighborhood Master Plan that addresses access management, pedestrian facilities, streetscape improvements, natural/scenic topographic features, environmental features, architectural/site design and mixed uses. This project represented an implementation action of the town's 2001 Comprehensive Plan.
