

# ALBANY BICYCLE MASTER PLAN IMPLEMENTATION PROGRAM

**Total Study Cost:** \$60,000 consultant effort

**Description:** CDTC is assisting the city of Albany with a Bicycle Master Plan implementation program that addresses development design standards; operational modeling and follow up planning work related to the recommendations in the recently completed Bicycle Master Plan. The implementation program will have two components: a bike-share feasibility study and a bicycle signage program. The study objectives are to identify a route and signage system that will connect the City's business districts, parks, neighborhoods, waterfront and cultural amenities, identify designated destinations, including signs to inform bicyclists of bicycle route direction changes and confirmation signs for route direction, distance and destination, and identify modeling methods and current bike-share communities to determine the preferred bike-share program and bike-share station locations and amenities.

This study was initiated in June 2012.
