
WATERVLIET BICYCLE MASTER PLAN



Proposed study area with emphasis on the Mohawk-Hudson Bike-Hike Trail in the City of Watervliet, New York.

Total Study Cost: \$60,000 (\$50,000 consultant effort plus \$10,000 in CDTC staff technical assistance)

Description: CDTC is assisting the City of Watervliet with a consultant effort to develop a Bicycle Master Plan. The plan will identify bicycle network needs and improvements and will address bicycle policies, signage and safety issues throughout the City. Of particular interest is an evaluation of alignment options for the segment of the Mohawk-Hudson Bike-Hike Trail that is currently located on Broadway. Other issues to be investigated include options for rerouting the existing Route 32 NYSDOT bike route to facilitate bicycle transportation in the City, the adequacy of bicycle parking in the City and the availability of appropriate bicycle storage/parking in proximity to the Route 32 and Route 2 CDTA transit corridors. Funding options to implement the plan are also to be identified.

This study was initiated in March 2013.
