

SARATOGA SPRINGS DOWNTOWN PARKING STUDY

Total Study Cost: \$15,000 consultant effort

Description: Downtown Saratoga Springs has faced a parking shortage during the summer tourism months for many years. More recently, however, downtown development including new housing and offices has resulted in a year round parking shortage on most weekdays. The purpose of this study is to initiate a community-wide dialogue regarding potential strategies to address current and future parking needs. Along with addressing parking needs, the study also investigates the downtown circulation system and looks at alternatives to auto-oriented travel within downtown. The study identified a number of short, medium and long term strategies and actions for increasing the parking supply based on an analysis of existing conditions and comments from the general public at a public workshop.
