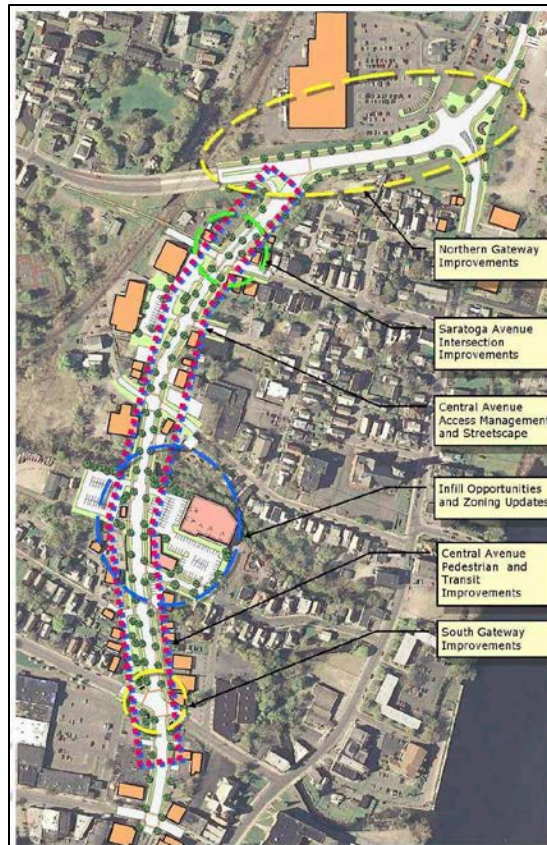


MECHANICVILLE CENTRAL AVENUE CORRIDOR LINKAGE STUDY

Total Study Cost: \$60,000 consultant effort

Description: The City of Mechanicville is engaged in a number of revitalization and planning efforts. To complement these efforts, the City initiated the Central Avenue Corridor study with the goal of maximizing the function of Central Avenue, providing safe and comfortable pedestrian and bicycle facilities, improving the look and feel of the corridor to encourage healthy economic development, and identifying locations where infill development could bolster the overall economic vitality of the corridor. Study recommendations include intersection improvements such as roundabouts, realignments and pedestrian crossings, access management, pedestrian and streetscape improvements, a zoning code update, and the establishment of a potential park and ride lot.
