
BURDECK STREET CORRIDOR TRAFFIC STUDY UPDATE

Total Study Cost: \$10,000 CDTC Staff Activity

Description: CDTC staff finalized the *Traffic Planning Study for the Burdeck Street Corridor* in June 1995. As the town updates its comprehensive plan, the need to revisit and update the earlier planning study has arisen due to new development proposals and growth that has occurred in the corridor since the 1995 study was completed. This study essentially serves as a supplement to the earlier planning study and does not replace it. The update found that growth in the Burdeck Street study area has not occurred at the pace anticipated back in 1995. As a result, many of the recommendations in the earlier study still hold true based on the new target growth scenario for the corridor. The recommendations include encouraging travel demand management activities within the town and corridor and active arterial management planning including driveway consolidation, signal coordination, low cost intersection improvements, and bicycle, pedestrian and transit accommodations.
