

# McKOWNVILLE CORRIDOR STUDY



Existing conditions (2002) in the McKownville neighborhood in the Town of Guilderland, New York.

**Total Study Cost:** \$40,000 consultant effort

**Description:** McKownville is an older, well-established neighborhood bisected by Western Avenue, a major high volume arterial road. Designed to move cars, Western Avenue essentially disconnects the neighborhood from itself due to a poor pedestrian environment and high vehicle speeds. This study creates a vision for the McKownville neighborhood that offers residents opportunities for walking and bicycling, enhances transit service, calms traffic and improves the safety of all roadway users through access management techniques.

Recommendations fall under the following categories:

- Pedestrian and Bicycle Improvements
- Trails and Recreational Areas
- Transit Service and Facilities
- Intermodal Facilitation (Bicycles, Pedestrians and Transit)
- Traffic Operation Enhancements
- Gateways
