Explanation for Requested Change:

This amendment is being proposed to change the cost of the allocated amount from \$6,100,000.00 to \$5,709,868.75 due to decreases in funding. This amendment also needs to reallocate the funding from construction (C) to preliminary design (P), detailed design (D) and construction (C); currently all of the funding is located in construction (C).

Advised by NYSDOT Region 1, the City needs to obligate this funding by September 2014. To achieve this goal, the Corning Preserve improvements that can be obligated by September 2014 include the following:

- Construction of a new multi-use path paralleling Quay Street;
- Installation of a new pedestrian crossing at Colonie Street between the OGS parking lot and Corning Preserve;
- Pedestrian and bicyclist improvements at the Broadway/Maiden Lane Bridge intersection; and
- Streetscape improvements along Quay Street.

In the table below, we show the current and proposed TIP allocation for this project.
