

**Amendments to the 2007-12 TIP**

At its October 1, 2008 meeting, the CDTC Planning Committee recommended the following amendments to the Transportation Improvement Program.

**1. Safe Routes to Schools**

The Safe Routes to Schools projects have been selected and sent to CDTC for inclusion in the TIP. The Planning Committee approved all four in the CDTC area. Two were added to the TIP by the Planning Committee's action: 1) Bethlehem Orchard St Ped Improvements (A504, 1758.09), and 2) Colonie Sand Creek Middle School Bike/Ped Program (A505, 1758.13). Due to funding thresholds, Policy Board approval is required for the other two as shown below. The fund source SRTS (Safe Routes to Schools) shows in the project listings for the first time with the addition of this batch of Safe Routes to Schools projects.
