Amendments to the 2010-15 TIP

During an emergency conference call on March 9, 2012, CDTC made the following amendments to the Transportation Improvement Program (TIP).

Both of the amendments are in regard to the proposed New York Works Program, which proposes to use "Advance Construction" funds for a statewide program to repair bridge decks and preserve pavements. The State added the projects to the Statewide TIP (STIP), because of the statewide nature of the projects, but MPO approval is required for funds to be spent in their respective MPO areas. State Legislative approval is still required at this time. NYSDOT will announce the specific roads and bridges to be included in these two projects once the Legislature approves the state budget. CDTC will then make that information available on its Web site.

1. RG122, Accelerated Pavement Preservation Program

This project will preserve more than 2,000 lane miles of roads statewide with low cost preservation treatments. The total funding statewide is \$250M spread across several fund sources. Funding information for the Capital District area has not been disclosed. Therefore, the TIP listing will not include funding information.

2. RG123, Accelerated Bridge Program

This project will rehabilitate over 100 bridge decks statewide. The total funding statewide is \$212M spread across several fund sources. Funding information for the Capital District area has not been disclosed. Therefore, the TIP listing will not include funding information.
