

## **REQUEST FOR EXPRESSIONS OF INTEREST (REI)**

### **US Route 4 Corridor Study Inter-municipal Update issued by**

**Capital District Transportation Committee  
Albany, N.Y.**

The Capital District Transportation Committee (CDTC) is the designated Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) carrying out federal requirements for cooperative transportation planning and programming in Albany, Rensselaer, Saratoga, and Schenectady Counties (except for the Town of Moreau and the Village of South Glens Falls) in New York State. CDTC is requesting expressions of interest from qualified firms or individuals to undertake the US Route 4 Corridor Study Inter-municipal Update in the Town of East Greenbush and Town of North Greenbush, New York.

The US Route 4 Corridor Study Inter-municipal Update was proposed by the Town of East Greenbush, with support from the Town of North Greenbush. The intended outcome of the Study is a preferred corridor profile, based on a representative public input process that provides a clear implementation strategy to improve transportation operations, and accommodates future growth and development.

The study is being funded by the CDTC and the Town of East Greenbush through CDTC's 2021-22 Community and Transportation Linkage Planning Program. The study has a fixed budget of \$90,000 for consultant services. CDTC, on behalf of the Town of East Greenbush, will administer the consultant contract and will jointly manage the study with the Town. CDTC and the Town of East Greenbush would like to see this study completed within 12 calendar months from the date of contract execution.
