## 2017 FTA 5310 Enhanced Mobility of Seniors and Individuals with Disabilities Program Applications Received, Evaluation Process and NYSDOT Approved Funding

**Introduction:** Applications for NYSDOT's 2017 solicitation for the FTA <u>Section 5310 - Enhanced Mobility of Seniors and Individuals with Disabilities Program</u> were due on August 21, 2017.

Fourteen (14) applications were submitted requesting funding from the 5310 Program for the CDTC planning area. Thirteen (13) applications were within the Albany-Schenectady-Troy urbanized area and one (1) was within the Saratoga Springs urbanized area.

Requested funds exceeded available funds as shown below:

**Evaluation Committee Review:** An evaluation committee of staff from the NYS Department of Health, NYS Office of Aging, NYSDOT and CDTC reviewed each application based on evaluation methodology from NYSDOT including consistency with CDTC's adopted Public Transit – Human Services Transportation Coordinated Plan. The evaluation committee met and submitted scores to NYSDOT in October 2017. Since requested funds exceeded available funds, the evaluation committee recommended a programming option. NYSDOT accepted the scoring and approved the following for funding.
