## DRAFT LOCAL ROAD SAFETY ACTION PLAN AVAILABLE FOR REVIEW



The Local Road Safety Action Plan has been in development by CDTC through the Regional Operations and Safety Advisory Committee and the project consultant team since early 2018. An analysis of crash data found that 50% of all reported crashes in CDTC's planning area occur on local roads, or those owned by counties, towns, villages and cities. In addition, over 1,800 people were either killed or injured on local roads between 2011 and 2016 (300 people per year or 25 people per month).

The Plan provides a toolbox of strategies for local government and regional stakeholders that have the greatest potential to reduce fatal and serious injury crashes and to reduce the overall number of crashes on local roads. The crash data analysis led to the following six emphasis areas:

- Intersections
- Lane Departure
- Vulnerable Users
- Age-Related
- Road User Behavior
- Speed
