

RESOLUTION #22-2

AMEND THE 2022-2023 UNIFIED PLANNING WORK PROGRAM

WHEREAS the Capital District Transportation Committee (CDTC) has been designated by the Governor of the State of New York as the Metropolitan Planning Organization responsible for the comprehensive, continuing, and cooperative transportation planning process in Albany-Schenectady and Saratoga Springs Urbanized Areas as required by Title 23, U.S.C. Section 134 and Title 49 U.S.C. Section 5303; and

WHEREAS the Capital District Transportation Committee's metropolitan planning area includes Albany, Rensselaer, Saratoga, and Schenectady counties, except the Town of Moreau and the Village of South Glens Falls; and

WHEREAS, 23 CFR Section 450.308 and 49 CFR Section 613.100 state that the Unified Planning Work Program shall annually describe all urban transportation and transportation related planning activities anticipated within the metropolitan planning area during the 2022-2023 state fiscal year (beginning April 1, 2022 and ending March 31, 2023) regardless of funding sources; and

WHEREAS, the Capital District Transportation Committee approved the 2022-2023 Unified Planning Work Program at its March 3, 2022 Policy Board meeting; and

WHEREAS, the Federal Transit Administration posted Federal Fiscal Year 2022 Section 5303 Metropolitan Planning Program (MPP) apportionments; and

WHEREAS, the Capital District Transportation Committee was allocated an additional \$106,767 by the New York State Department of Transportation to be obligated in the 2022-2023 Unified Planning Work Program; and

WHEREAS, the CDTC Planning Committee approved an amendment to the 2022-2023 Unified Planning Work Program at its May 4, 2022 meeting to reflect the increased allocation.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Capital District Transportation Committee approves the amended 2022-2023 Unified Planning Work Program for the metropolitan planning area; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Capital District Transportation Committee authorizes the Planning Committee to make minor revisions and refinements consistent with the overall intent of the Unified Planning Work Program that are necessary during the course of the year; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Capital District Transportation Committee authorizes the New York State Department of Transportation to submit the Unified Planning Work Program to the Federal Highway Administration to secure PL, SPR and STP funding and authorizes the New York State Department of Transportation to submit an application to the Federal Transit Administration (FTA) to secure Section 5303 funds, on behalf of the Committee.
