Dear Ms. Misiewicz:

The City of Rensselaer and New York State Department of Transportation (NYSDOT) have been coordinating the construction of the Multi-use Trail (referenced above) in the vicinity of the Livingston Avenue Bridge due to the construction footprint of the replacement bridge.

Given the overlap of the project limits, NYSDOT has agreed to construct a portion of the project as indicated in the proposed TIP amendment submitted by Robert E. Rice, P.E., NYSDOT Region One Regional Planning and Program Manager.

The City of Rensselaer concurs with the NYSDOT proposed TIP amendment to construct the trail in two phases. NYSDOT will construct Phase 1 from Delaets Landing to the Amtrak Bridge Approach in FFY 24-25 and the City of Rensselaer will construct Phase 2 from the Amtrak Bridge Approach to Hilton Park and Boat Launch in FFY 26-27.
