

2022-2027 TIP PROJECT TYPE DESCRIPTIONS

Road Projects

Use this application for projects that will repave or reconstruct a road, correct pavement deficiencies, or repave a road to implement a complete street striping plan, road diet, HOV lane or bus lane, etc. Also use this application for road widening projects or to build a new road. Sponsors may indicate if a group of applications are to be bundled and evaluated as a single project. For questions related to complex projects, contact CDTC.

Bridge Projects

A bridge is defined as having a span length equal to or greater than 20 feet. Use this application to maintain, repair or rehabilitate a bridge, replace an existing bridge, or construct a new bridge for motor vehicles, bicycles, or pedestrians. Propose work beyond the limits of the bridge in a separate application. Sponsors may indicate if a group of applications are to be bundled and evaluated as a single project. For questions related to complex projects, contact CDTC.

Bicycle Facilities Projects

Use this application to resurface or reconstruct existing bicycle facilities, or to construct new bicycle facilities. Bicycle facilities may be on road (i.e., bike lanes) or off-road (i.e., shared use trails). Also use this application to widen existing bicycle facilities or to install bicycle related traffic control devices.

DO NOT use this application if the project proposes road repaving to install bicycle facilities or a complete street. Sponsors may indicate if a bicycle project proposal is to be bundled and evaluated with other applications as a single project. For questions related to complex projects, contact CDTC.

Pedestrian Facilities

Use this application to rehabilitate or reconstruct existing pedestrian facilities, to construct new pedestrian facilities, to widen pedestrian facilities or to install pedestrian related traffic control devices.

DO NOT use this application if the project proposes road repaving to install pedestrian facilities or if the project is related to shared use trails. Sponsors may indicate if a pedestrian project proposal is to be bundled and evaluated with other applications as a single project. For questions related to complex projects, contact CDTC.

Safety Projects

Use this application for site specific or systemic safety projects that reduce crashes at high crash locations, reduce the number of fatal or serious injury crashes or reduce the risk of crashes ([the systemic approach](#)). The need for a safety project may be demonstrated through recent crash history, a safety assessment/technical analysis or a road safety audit. All public roads are eligible for Highway Safety Improvement Program funds.

Projects that are consistent with the New York State [Strategic Highway Safety Plan](#), [Pedestrian Safety Action Plan](#), CDTC's [Local Road Safety Action Plan](#) or utilize [FHWA's Proven Safety Countermeasures](#) are highly encouraged. Sponsors may indicate if a group of applications are to be bundled and evaluated as a single project. For questions related to complex projects or to request crash data, contact CDTC.

Other Project Types

Use this application for projects that do not fit into the road, bridge, pedestrian, bicycle or safety categories such as transit infrastructure, intersection improvements (for a purpose other than safety), signal projects, operational/ITS projects, economic development/community compatibility projects, etc. Sponsors may indicate if a group of applications are to be bundled and evaluated as a single project.
